Rent during semester breaks: Additional rent charges apply for persons wishing to arrive early or remain in student housing beyond the normal semester schedule. Early or extended stay is subject to housing availability.

Protecting Your Possessions: Ethnos Canada's property insurance provides very limited coverage for student's belongings while on campus. Students should therefore consider obtaining tenant's coverage to fully insure their possessions.

Finances and Donations from Supporters

Because the Emanate missionary training program is specifically tailored to cross-cultural church planting and is normally mandatory for all persons planning to become employees of Ethnos Canada, Ethnos360 (U.S.A.) or any of the other international organizations which are signatories to the Global Ministry Agreement, the training program is considered employment-related. Consequently contributions made to offset the cost of tuition are eligible for official receipts for Canadian income-tax purposes¹. All such contributions should be made payable to **Ethnos Canada** and accompanied by a note designating the support as for the Emanate training program (with the student's name).

Financial gifts given for the personal expenses of students (including rent) are not eligible for official receipts.

Other Financial Information

- Lack of payment or late payments may lead to removal from the training program. However extenuating circumstances will be taken into consideration by the Emanate leadership Team.
- Payments may be made by:
 - Cash (at the Ethnos Canada headquarters office reception area),
 - Cheque (made payable to **Ethnos Canada**),
 - Electronic funds transfers from your bank account as
 - Individual eTransfers arranged to finance@ethnos.ca
 - Recurring pre-authorized bank account debits ("PAD"), or
 - Online credit card transaction (<http://emanatetraining.ca/emanate-payments/>).
- If you or others wish to make payments or contributions on a monthly basis, you might consider arranging for automatic pre-authorized bank account debit ("PAD") with NTMC. Information and forms are available upon request.
- An Ethnos Canada account is created for all students upon acceptance to the Emanate training program. Charges for tuition, rent and any other course/campus-related expense will be charged against this account. Students may not use this account to hold excess personal funds.



¹ Please note that this option is only available for Canadian tax-payers and for those contributions sent to Ethnos Canada. Contributions sent to the Ethnos360 in the United States are not eligible for income tax receipts.
